Hank Williams, My son calls another man dad usually a Southern Gothic story from Hank - father in prison and watches his son be brought up with a better man. Eddy Arnold, My Dad is just a Picture Another heartbreaker, this time for a little boy whose (dead) father exists only as a memory. Sheb Wooley, That's My Pa Comic novelty, where Sheb tells the story of a drunken yet lovable dad, complete with loony imitation. Donna Fargo, Dad, in which Donna discovers that a simple call home to see how dad does is actually a cry for father's help. Clarence Carter, Patches a heartbreaking General Johnson tune on his father's early exit and put his family's legacy. Gladys Knight and Pips, Dad would swear, I declare Proving that you don't have to be a leave beaver wholesome to bring up children well. Horace Silver, Song for My Father A hard-bop classic later appropriated by Steely Dan (Rikki Don't Lose That Number) and Stevie Wonder (Don't You Worry Bout Thing). James Brown, Papa Don't Mess James reminiscence isn't exactly all the sun (Papa beat the hell out of us), but it's positive (and super funky) anyway. Temptations, Papa Was Rolling Stone Perhaps the most famous song here, a sad story about a fatherless family without even good memories to hang on to. Winstons, Color Him Father Happy and a unique twist on the missing father of the genre, with the singer taking his new father after the death of his biological one. Wayne Newton, Daddy Don't You Walk So Fast Perhaps the best-known hit of the genre, a tearful tune almost dropping from a child's perspective. Elvis Presley, Don't Cry Daddy A real weeper from Elvis's historic Memphis session, where a widower takes comfort from his children's love. Monkees, Daddy's Song It sounds carefree, but listen close and you'll find songwriter Harry Nilsson reveals the scars of early abandonment. The Beach Boys, I'm Bugged at My Ol Man Only comic relief, here's another Brian Wilson number where he dramatically illuminates the extent of his father's grounding – just like a real teen would. Giorgio Moroder, the Son of My Father Electro-disco produced by the pioneer, had his lonely solo hit with this, surprisingly lyrically intricate number about shaking off his father's legacy to find his identity. Harry Chapin, Kat is cradling a huge hit in which a son whose son never had time for him to learn that he was repeating his family history with his child. Cat Stevens, Father and Son Moves the popular story of a generational divide: a father with the best intentions and a son who feels compelled to find his way anyway. John Lennon, Beautiful Boy (Darling Boy) One of John's most tender ballads that says something – a touching lullame that turns into meditation on life. Life.
